Sequence:  $Intro + (A.B) \times 4$ 

Note: A and B each include the repeat as written – i.e. A and B are 8 bars each. Some people would write this as  $Intro + (2A.2B) \times 4$ .



#### **Bromsberrow Heath**

Sequence: Intro  $+(2A.B) \times 4$ .

Start slowly for the first A.

Increase speed at the beginning of each B (sticking/capering part).

First B: normal speed

Second B: fast Third V: faster

Fourth B: stupidly fast.
